of the Principal of the Doctoral School of Medical and Health Sciences
dated 10 June 2021

regarding: start of the recruitment process for a PhD programme in medical sciences at the Doctoral School of Medical and Health Sciences under a special competitive procedure

Acting on the basis of § 7.3 of Resolution No. 4/I/2021 of the Senate of the Jagiellonian University dated 27 January 2021 regarding the rules of recruitment to the Doctoral School of Medical and Health Sciences in the academic year 2021/2022, I hereby resolve as follows:

§ 1

I hereby announce the recruitment to an interdisciplinary PhD Programme in Medical and Health Sciences at the Doctoral School of Medical and Health Sciences, under a special competitive procedure, in English, for the purpose of recruiting a PhD student as part of the project “Effects of pharmacological modulation of cellular metabolism on myocarditis in a mouse model”, Project No. U1C/P04/NO/01.01 (hereinafter: “the Project”).

§ 2

The competition for admission to the Doctoral School may be entered by an individual who meets the formal entry requirements as specified in Resolution No. 4/I/2021 of the Senate of the Jagiellonian University of 27 January 2021 regarding the Rules of Recruitment to the Doctoral School of Medical and Health Sciences in the Academic Year 2020/2021 and Resolution No. 16/III/2021 of the Senate of the Jagiellonian University of 31 March 2021 regarding amendments to Resolution No. 4/I/2021 of the Senate of the Jagiellonian University of 27 January 2021 on the Rules of Recruitment to the Doctoral School of Medical and Health Sciences at the Jagiellonian University in the Academic Year 2021/2022 (hereafter: “the Resolution”) and Appendix to Resolution No. 16/III/2021 of the Senate of the Jagiellonian University of 31 March 2021 (Detailed Conditions and Recruitment Procedure to the Doctoral School of Medical and Health Sciences at the Jagiellonian University in the Academic Year 2021/2022 for a 6-Semester Educational Programme in English).

The formal conditions indicated in the Resolution concerning the independent performance of medical procedures are excluded as such activities are not covered by the Project.

1. An individual seeking admission to the Doctoral School should also fulfil the formal and substantive requirements specified in the project application (Application No. qL.1.1.2021.2 of 17 February 2021) and in the Regulations of Awarding Mini-Grants

for Co-Financing of Interdisciplinary Teams Carrying Out Research Projects with Participation of a PhD student of the Doctoral School of Medical and Health Sciences of the Jagiellonian University's Medical College within the POB "Quality of Research for Quality of Life – qLife" under the strategic programme Excellence Initiative at the Jagiellonian University (hereinafter: "the Regulations") and in the requirements of the project competition entitled "Effects of pharmacological modulation of cellular metabolism on myocarditis in a mouse model" for a PhD scholarship defined by the Project Manager.

§ 3

1. The appointment of the Committee, the announcement of the recruitment and the recruitment procedure shall be carried out in accordance with the Regulations, with due regard to the principles specified in the Resolution and this Communication, as well as in the requirements of the competition for a PhD scholarship defined by the Project Manager for the project entitled "Effect of pharmacological modulation of cellular metabolism on myocarditis in a mouse model".

3. The recruitment is conducted outside of the electronic candidate registration system.
4. The Competition Committee will include at least one representative of the Council of the Doctoral School of Medical and Health Sciences.
5. Members of the Competition Committee are required to fill in a relevant "no conflict of interest" clause in accordance with § 3.9 of the Resolution.

§ 4

1. The Competition Committee will immediately notify the Principal of the Doctoral School of Medical and Health Sciences of the outcome of the recruitment process independently of the publication of the competition outcome.
2. The rules of admitting and rejecting students at the Doctoral School specified in the Act on Higher Education and Science of 20 July 2018 shall apply.
