Quality criteria for publications for the First and Second Degree Awards

## Individual First Degree Award:

- 1. A scientific article, within the meaning of the relevant regulation on the evaluation of the quality of research activity, in a scientific journal or peer-reviewed materials from an international scientific conference, which is included in the list of journals of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education as of 01.01.2022, and has been assigned at least 200 points; or a scientific monograph or a chapter of a scientific monograph, within the meaning of the relevant regulation on the evaluation of the quality of research activity, published in a publishing house from the list of publishers at level II.
- The PhD student/doctoral programme participant is the sole, first, or corresponding author (on condition there is a maximum of two first or corresponding authors).

## **Individual Second Degree Award:**

1. A scientific article in a scientific journal or peer-reviewed materials from an international scientific conference, within the meaning of the relevant regulation on the evaluation of the quality of research activity, which is included in the list of journals of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education as of 01.01.2022, and has been assigned at least 140 points; or a scientific monograph or a chapter of a scientific monograph, within the meaning of the relevant regulation on the evaluation of the quality of research activity, from the list of publishers at level I.

2. The PhD student/doctoral programme participant is the sole, first, or corresponding author (on condition there is a maximum of two first or corresponding authors).
