Quality criteria for conferences/research visits/ open-access publications

## Conference:

- 1. International conference (based on information from conference materials or conference website)
- 2. Active participation of a PhD student (presentation of a lecture or a conference report in spoken form, poster or e-poster form, based on an invitation or information that the report has been accepted for presentation)
- 3. In the case of a conference report, the PhD student is the first author (on the condition that this refers to the situation when there is a maximum of two first authors).
- 4. Abstract and presentation in English or another foreign language.

## Research visit:

- 1. Duration of the visit from 5 to 30 days
- 2. Visit in a foreign research centre
- 3. High international reputation of the research centre (based on, e.g., certification by international scientific society, the title of the centre of excellence, number and quality of publications, etc.).

## *Open-access* publication:

- The PhD student is the first author or the corresponding author (on the condition there is a maximum of two first authors or two corresponding authors, respectively)
- 2. The publisher has accepted the work for publication, and it has a DOI number (Digital Object Identifier);

3.	The journal is indexed in JCR and has a score of at least 70 MEiN points according to the list of 01.01.2022 or the Impact Factor from Q1 to Q2.
