regarding: the duty to inform and promote under the programme Excellence Initiative at the Jagiellonian University


I would like to inform you that on 5th September 2022 the Communication by the Head of the Board for the Implementation of the Strategic Programme ID.UJ was published, concerning the duty to inform and promote under the programme Excellence Initiative at the Jagiellonian University.

In order to perform the duty to inform and promote the conducted activities in the programme ID.UJ, which oblige the University to inform the public (including the programme results' recipients) and persons and entities participating in it on the awarded funding, I introduce the following rules for indicating the results of research papers, achievements, the results of the conducted research or purchase of research equipment.

Depending on the source of funding, which may be one of the Priority Research Areas (POB) or financial resources awarded under the ID.UJ for particular entities of Jagiellonian University, you are asked to describe publications/research/equipment in accordance with the following paradigm:
